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#### The European scenario (2 main ideas)

National authorities have full competences in the regulation of education.

Regulations about the structure and quality of the HE study programmes, awarding powers / recognition.

EU promotes the establishment and development of common frameworks.

- Directives + projects + funds




#### The quality in the European HE Area


The Bologna Process means the establishment of the EHEA.

- Compatible structure of degrees (bachelor + Master + PhD)
- Academic infrastructure (similar schemes for programme description: ECTS)
- Quality assurance scheme for the European universities (ESG)
























































## The ESG (shared responsibilities)


How quality is assured by HEI?

- Policy for QA
- Approval, monitoring and reviews of programmes
- Assessment of students
- QA of teaching staff
- Learning resources and student support
- Information systems
- Public information

## The ESG (shared responsibilities)



- Effectiveness of internal QA
- Aims and objectives for external QA determined before
- Criteria for decisions be explicit and published
- Designed to ensure their fitness for purpose
- Reports to be published
- Follow up procedures
- Periodic reviews
- System-wide analysis



#### **European QA for joint programmes**

- Common guidelines for transnational evaluations (shared criteria).
- Focused on QA (possible application to all disciplines)
- International review teams
- Students involved in external reviews
- Public reports
- Evaluation with qualitative statements



## **European QA for joint programmes (limitations)**

- Cost of the process (different site visits for one single programme).
- Pilot experiences with no accreditation purposes
- Accreditation (QA agencies) is not equivalent to recognition (Ministries)
- Ex ante QA not sufficiently developed
- Differences in quality standards between countries (some contradictions)
- Differences in quality assurance schemes (e.g. validity of accreditations)



## The JOQAR project



#### **Cross-border quality assurance of joint programmes**

- Development of multilateral mutual recognition agreements
- Establishment of a European Coordination point for external QA and accreditation of joint programmes

#### Recognition of degrees awarded by joint programmes

- Awareness-raising about ENIC-NARICs' expectations regarding joint programmes, the design of the degree they award and the content of the diploma supplement
- Establishment of a common ground among ENIC-NARICs regarding the recognition of degrees awarded by joint programmes.
- Transparent information provision regarding Erasmus Mundus programmes via Qrossroads







#### **Core criteria**

- Standard 1 General conditions
  - Recognition (legal framework)
  - Cooperation agreement
  - Added value
- Standard 2 Intended learning outcomes
  - Shared
  - Level (qualification frameworks)
  - Subject /discipline
- Standard 3 Programme
  - Admission
  - Structure (curriculum content)
  - Credits (distribution)



#### Core criteria

- Standard 4 Internal Quality assurance
  - Common understanding (shared)
  - Stakeholders involvement
  - Continuous improvement
- Standard 5 Facilities and student support
  - Facilities
  - Support (student support)
  - Services (housing, visa issues....)
- Standard 6 Teaching and learning
  - Staff
  - Assessment of students
  - Achievement (learning outcomes



#### **Examples of national criteria**

- On national assessment criteria:
  - The Master's dissertation should range from 15 to 30 ECTS credits.
- On national procedure criteria:
  - The assessment panel needs to come to a general conclusion regarding the joint programme. This general conclusion is either unsatisfactory, satisfactory, good or excellent and needs to be weighted and substantiated.




