




- Basileus I started in summer 2008 and was the first large-scale mobility project with the Western Balkan region;
- Basileus II was launched in the summer of 2009;
- Basileus I &II have awarded around 700 mobility grants to students, researchers and staff members and ended successfully on the 30th of November 2011;
- •Basileus III started in the summer of 2010 and foresees around 280 mobilities, the project will end in November 2014.



BASILEUS IV – Introduction (1)



- Erasmus Mundus Action 2 project / funded by the EC;
- 9 EU universities -10 universities in the Western Balkans (1 joint coordinator 'first time within Basileus');
- provides funding for academic mobility from
 - any Western Balkan institution to one of the EU partner universities;
 - one of the EU partner universities to one of the Western Balkan partner universities.



BASILEUS IV – Introduction (2)




• Eligible Western Balkan countries are: Albania, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Montenegro, Macedonia (Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia), Kosovo (under UNSCR 1244/99) Serbia;

• 270 Mobility flows: 30% Bachelor, 35 % Master, 15% Doctorate, 5% Post-Doc, 15% Staff - Overview

• Budget: € 3.999.800


BASILEUS IV - Objectives



- Enhance international cooperation capacity in WB: ECTS, mobility management, academic recognition;
- Promote cooperation EU WB: structured longterm cooperation;
- Offering students opportunities to develop skills for future leadership;
- Improve transparency and recognition of studies/qualifications;
- Give extra chances to vulnerable groups: 9 grants;
- Enhance the skills of staff, who will improve their education system: 15 % of the scholarships;
- 52 mobility flows for TG 2 which will focus on Master/PhD to strenghten university-enterprise cooperation;
- Contribute to improving mutual understanding between EU and WB by enabling personal contacts - the future of the WB lies within Europe!



Joint-coordinator (1)



-University of Novi Sad

- -will take the lead in the promotion activities in the third countries, especially for target group 2 & 3 and the communication with the associate partners involved in promotion;
- will act as the official representative of the project towards authorities in the region, such as EC delegations, Ministries of Education, embassies etc.
- in case of problems (e.g. visa problems, problems defining Target Groups) intervenes fast;

Joint-coordinator (2)



- University of Novi Sad
 - during the selection procedure:
 - will do the validation for the TG 2 and 3 candidates;
 - will be present at selection meetings, along with other partners.
 - will assist in organization and preparation of consortium meetings and additional activities in the region;
 - will take active part in the analysis of the results of the evaluations and monitorings, formulate recommendations for improvements;

Joint-coordinator(3)



- University of Novi Sad
 - will play an important role for sustainability in the region;
 - will be responsible for the sustainability plan which the consortium will establish (starting at the kick-off meeting);
 - will encourage regional meetings to strenghten the regional cooperation.
